| POSITION | Sunday Service Prayer Leader |
| GOAL OF POSITION | To lead prayers for ourselves and others during the Sunday service. |
| KEY FUNCTIONS | <p>The prayer leader will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Having regard to the focus of the opening prayer of the morning service, offered by the Service Leader, being confession and thanksgiving, offer prayers of petition including:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- For the various ministries of our church- For mission, including Joshua and Christina Hahn, SECET, APWM- For the Minister and his family- For our community- For the world – specific current issues including persecuted Christians- For those who are unwell (see note below)- Adjust the height of the microphone so it is directed towards your mouth. Do this using the long arm holding the microphone and not the microphone clamp.- Read the prayer at a speed which is not too fast or too slow. Where applicable, brief pauses may assist members of the congregation to reflect upon items in your prayer. |
